Budget

The **budget** consists of personal costs, group costs, and ministry expenses. For this itinerary & number of people (11), the cost is **\$900/person + \$1,150/Flight = \$ 2,050.00**

Personal Costs

Personal costs include lodging, food, bottled water, and activities. Anything denoted by a (\$) in the itinerary indicates that the team member will be responsible for assuming that optional cost.

Group Costs

Transportation & administration represent the group costs, which are divided amongst the number of trip participants. Administration includes things like food & hotel stays for missionaries and other necessary staff members throughout the stay of the mission team. It also includes the cost of meals eaten with the mission team for any invited guests/pastors throughout the duration of the stay of the mission team.

Additional Expenses Not Reflected in the Budget

Trip Insurance:

Our Policy Terms Recommendations:

We highly recommend you purchase a policy with at least a \$150,000 maximum for medical bills. We also suggest the policy includes coverage for emergency medical evacuation, transportation of mortal remains, and an adventure sports rider.

If We Had to Recommend a Policy:

We recommend going to www.imgur.com and purchasing the “Patriot International Platinum Plan” (\$2,000,000 coverage limit) and adding the “Adventure Sports Rider” when you get to the coverage add-ons option. This policy usually costs around \$2-3/day.

In-Country Medical Expenses

Any medical expenses incurred while in Ecuador are the responsibility of the trip participant and will need to be paid at the time of receiving the medical care. This is why each trip participant needs to purchase a short-term medical travel insurance policy so that the trip participant can be reimbursed for the medical expenses they may incur while in Ecuador.
